Not Sure What To Do?

+/- (“Plus/Minus”) is a statistic that the coaches have asked to be kept, although it is not an official part of the score sheet. This is very simple in concept, but requires you to pay constant attention to the game and the players that are on the ice.

Basically, if a player is on the ice when a goal is scored for the Cougars, he/she receives a ‘+1’ and if they are on the ice when the opponent scores, it’s a ‘-1’ (not including goalies).

Official +/- statistics kept by the NHL have certain power play/penalty kill provisions. For Cougar purposes, don’t worry about these – every goal counts.

You’ll need to bring something to write with and some extra paper. It’s best to position yourself where you can see the numbers of the players as they leave the ice.

The easiest method is to use a separate paper to keep track of players on the ice at all times by noting their jersey number. Keeping offense and defense separated helps as the players usually play with the same linemates.

After the game, give the completed summary to the Cougar scorekeeper (usually Dawn).
